

## Vigilant Screenings

### Temperature Checkpoints

We have invested in high-tech, non touch thermal imaging devices that will be used at three different drop off doors at the school to quickly assess body temperatures while avoiding congregating. All students will complete a temperature check each morning on campus. Any child exhibiting a temperature of 100° or more will not be permitted to attend school. We will also have wellness and temperature screenings for all employees. Presentation asks that anyone who is showing symptoms of COVID-19 stays home for the safety and health of everyone at school.

### Nursing Isolation Rooms

We have expanded our nurse's office with additional space that will allow for a connected, but separate, isolation room for students who are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 and awaiting pick up. These two rooms will allow for proper physical distancing among ill kids. Presentation is ensuring that we are following all health and safety standards through communication with the local health department and CDC regarding COVID-19 protocol updates, testing, and reporting.

## Clean School Environment

Presentation has invested in state-of-the-art cleaning products to maintain a sanitized facility. The cleaning system includes an electrostatic sprayer that delivers a sanitation cleaning solution to the front, back, and sides of surfaces. We will regularly sanitize high-contact areas (i.e. doorknobs, banisters, and restroom facilities). Each teacher will lead a cleaning routine before, during, and after class. This will include hand washing, sanitizing, and cleaning of desks and materials.

## Face Coverings and Physical Distancing Efforts

All faculty, staff, students, and guests will be required to wear face coverings. Face shields with a ball cap and face masks are required in common areas. Face shields will be worn by teachers during class for students to articulate their words, hear what they are saying, and see the teacher's expression.

By offering in-person instruction to all students, we acknowledge that we need to achieve as much physical distancing as possible. We have adjusted classroom practices, hallway routes, and lunchroom routines to ensure the least amount of traffic and congregation. Our halls have visual cues to promote a safe distance between students. To further help hallway traffic students will not be switching classrooms for their classes, rather, the specialist will come to their specific classroom.

## Additional Information

This plan outlines Presentation's protocol report for our steps to prepare for re-opening for the 2020-2021 school year. We will continue to adjust and revise this plan based on guidance of COVID-19 throughout the school year. We pledge to keep you updated regarding any new developments. We remain committed to engaging all our students, families, and parishioners regardless of the distance between us. We are looking forward to seeing everyone's faces in school **August 31st**.



## Other Presentation Adaptations

### Prayer



Presentation will still host daily prayer for our students every morning. We may have mass pending on guidance from the Archdiocese of Saint Paul and Minneapolis. Masses will also be streamed and recorded for students to attend if at home or in class. Everyone will be allowed to participate in prayer.

### Lunch



All students will have the opportunity to participate in our healthy dining program Presentation has established. Lunch will occur outside as often as possible. Class times for lunch will be scattered providing for less traffic in Kenney Hall. The choice of hot lunch will still be provided to our students.

### Recess



When weather permits, students will continue to enjoy recess outside. Our property space allows us to easily separate students while having a big space to be active.

### Visitors On Campus



All visitors must schedule through the front office when they will be on Presentation's campus. We are encouraging this scheduling to avoid creating high traffic in the hallways, while also limiting heavy touch point usage. Visitors must undergo the proper health screening before entering.

### Sports



When Weather permits, students will continue physical education outside. All sports are currently suspended.

### School Events



We are committed to our strong school community. We are working on plans to adjust all school events so we can continue our traditions in new and innovative ways. More details on specific plans for each event will be shared in advance.

### Specialists



Rather than our classes switching classrooms to see specialists such as Spanish, Art, or Music the teachers will come to them. This will allow for less cross contamination, hallway traffic, and cleaning needed.

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
